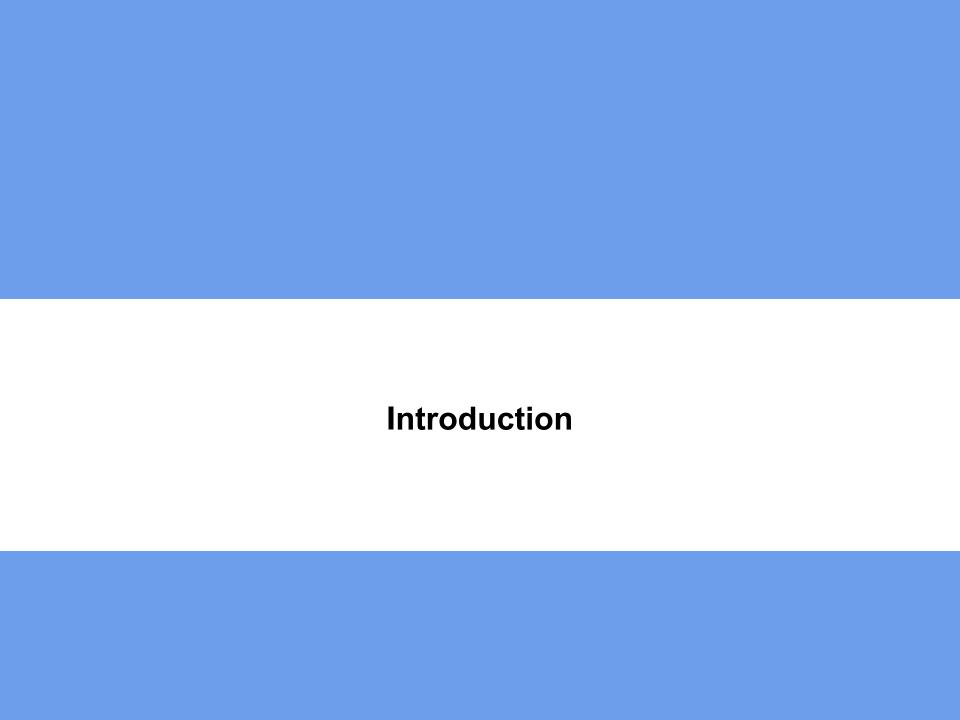



SUBGROUP STRUCTURE

The ECLC Transition Advisory Group is convening subgroups to offer insights that will guide the creation of a transition plan to the new unified department of early childhood. Each group will offer recommendations from their perspectives or in their areas of expertise.



How can we be sure to integrate Health, Mental Health, and Family Support into the new department?

Governance Ideas	Operation Ideas	Funding Ideas
1. Ensure that the leadership of the new department includes members from each of the Framework domains with the needed perspective and expertise. Also, that each domain is structurally represented in decision making.	1. Consider a new structure focused on outcomes and less on division (i.e. Division of Learning and Development) or service delivery types.	1. Allow/ensure intentional use of discretionary funding to support cross-collaborative work.
2. Collaboration should be written into statute or other formal guiding documents.	2. Data and fiscal expertise should stretch across projects the new department oversees.	2. Think creatively and be flexible with funding so that each domain is appropriately resourced and families are supported.
3. Consider ways to move programs that intentionally prioritized integration and removes siloes.	3. Create a common language and ensure that all stakeholders understand partner work.	3. Funding should be whole-family focused and include prevention.

EQUITY

- Education, employment, housing, financial and legal supports contribute to family economic security
- Families, including those with high needs, experience timely and coordinated services and supports
- Families have the ability to plan the number and timing of their children
- All environments are safe, free of toxins, have affordable foods and offer physical activity
- Children with special health, behavioral or developmental needs receive individualized services and supports
- All children are ready for school and achieving by 3rd grade regardless of ability, race, place, income, language and culture
- Children, including those with high needs, receive timely, comprehensive and affordable academic services and transition supports






